Measure your boat for Deckchute



Measure for the perfect fit

Details matter - Deckchute must be mounted correctly on your boat.

Deckchute must be stretched between two padeyes. See user guideline "Refit your boat for Deckchute sailing".

The correct Deckchute length for your boat is the length between the padeye on the foredeck and 10 cm in front of the jammers. Passing the mast Dechchute is supported by a strap.

To order a Deckchute for your boat you must measure length ${\bf A}$ and ${\bf B}$ and look up the size of your gennaker in m2's, which is ${\bf C}$.

You must Also measure the length between the forestay at the level of the deck and the point at the bow or the bowsprit where the tack line is turned, running the gennaker.

This length is **D**.

Further indicate if your boat features a retractable bowsprit. This information is **E**.
