Boats with the pit by the cockpit

Prepare the boat for Deckchute

Your boat may be fitted for Deckchute sailing as it is.

You need:

- Two padeyes or loopeyes.
- Two jammers (Spinlocks)

The Deckchute sits in port side of the boat, opposite to the spinnaker halyard.

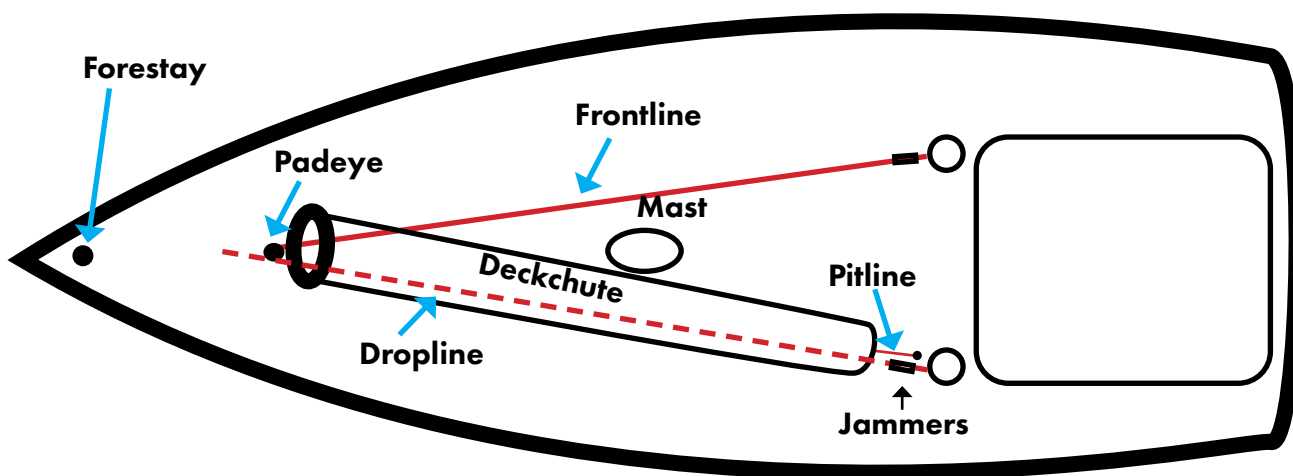
The Deckchute ring is attached by its frontline to a strong padeye or a loopeye on the foredeck.

Use the position for the downhaul or an inner forestay.

Aft the Deckchute is tied by its pitline to a small padeye or something at the pit.
(not a lot of load here)

Passing the mast the Deckchute have a strap for a mast line.

The frontline is locked in one jammer, the dropline is through another jammer.
